Technical Presentation:

Title: Designing Healthy Work Environments

Speaker: Lisa Hanson, Humanscale Ergonomic Consulting Services

Engaging key stakeholders is a critical first step in the development of an ergonomics program. This educational program elevates awareness of ergonomic concerns and provides an overview of common musculoskeletal problems facing today's intensive computer users. Key research developments in the areas of seating, input device design, display technology, lighting and employee level training are discussed. Program stakeholders will learn how ergonomics principles are being applied to the design of computer workstations in an effort to reduce employee discomfort and risk of injury while lowering employer costs.

Lisa Hanson is an associate ergonomist. She is currently based in Chicago and is responsible for providing coverage within the central region. She has worked as an injury prevention specialist and helped large corporations develop and maintain ergonomics, health and wellness programs that were intended to reduce musculoskeletal injury rates. Lisa has a doctor of physical therapy degree from Northwestern University and a bachelor of science in kinesiology from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign.
